

Honors College Internal Transfer Application

Students currently enrolled at Mason must complete two full semesters of study (minimum of 24 credit hours) before they can be considered for admission to the Honors College (students apply during their second semester at Mason, applications are reviewed once the second semester grades have posted).

An applicant's Mason record as well as any information submitted in the online application to the university may be considered. In some cases, an in person interview may be requested by the Honors College.

Current Mason student applicants should meet the following guidelines:

- Minimum of 24 credit hours completed (by the end of the semester you are applying)
- Minimum 3.5 cumulative GPA
- Applicants must submit one letter of recommendation from a Mason faculty member
- Applicants must submit the required essay

Applications must be submitted to the Honors College office by 5pm on April 15th.
